



SNHU Esports Summer Camp Behavior Policy

Camp goers are expected to always exhibit appropriate behavior while on campus and in the Esports Arena. The Esports Arena and the SNHU Esports Summer Camp are meant to be a fun and safe environment for people of all skill levels and backgrounds. As such, we require that all patrons of the SNHU Esports Summer Camp to always follow these guidelines (even during games):

- Keep things positive. Do not blame others, bully others, or use excessive foul language.
- Be safe. Do not act in a manner that could cause harm to yourself or others.
- Be respectful. Treat the equipment, personnel, and fellow camp-goers in the Esports Arena with care and respect.
- No food / drink at the computer stations.
- Keep your cool. Aggressive behavior and threats will not be permitted at the camp and will result in appropriate referrals to campus public safety if severe.
- Remember, esports is for everyone. Racism, sexism, and harassment will not be tolerated and will result in immediate written warning.

Listed below are the discipline procedures during the camp. As mentioned above, some behaviors will lead to more strict discipline measures such as immediate written warning as necessary:

Step 1: Verbal Warning

Step 2: Time Out: Removal from current activity. This may mean that a camp-goer must leave a game currently in progress. Parents/guardians will be notified of their child's Time Out.

Step 3: Written Warning: If severe or unacceptable behavior persists, a written warning will be issued. A Camp Counselor or Camp Director will reach out to speak with a parent/guardian. A Parent/Guardian will be required to sign the written warning and pick up their child from camp.

After receiving two written warnings, the child will be dropped from the SNHU Esports Summer Camp and will not be permitted to return in the future. No refunds will be given. Please review these rules with your child prior to the first day and submit this form at the beginning of the week.
